

Speaker Agreement & Copyright Policy

By execution of this agreement, I hereby accept ASD Inc.'s invitation to participate as a speaker or poster presenter at the Joint ASD, IEEE GRSS Symposium on the "Art, Science and Applications of Reflectance Spectroscopy" (ASARS) to be held February 23-25, 2010 in Boulder Colorado, and agree to abide by the terms and conditions set forth herein.

If I am unable to fulfill my speaking commitment or am unable to participate in the conference for any reason, I will notify ASD in writing as soon as possible, but preferably not less than thirty (30) days prior to the scheduled conference. Invited speakers agree to provide ASD with an Abstract by October 15, 2009 and a Proceedings Paper by December 1, 2009. For poster presenters, required Abstracts are due by December 1, 2009 and requested Proceedings Papers by January 15, 2010.

I understand that ASD reserves the right to reproduce, publish and distribute my conference presentation and Proceedings Paper in the conference materials that will be made available to all the registrants during and after the ASARS Symposium. By my acceptance of the terms and conditions of this agreement and release and in consideration of ASD providing me with the opportunity to speak and present my work at the Symposium, I hereby grant ASD Inc. a perpetual license to: (1) copy, reproduce, publish and distribute the work in all print and other formats (including but not limited to online publication via ASD's Web site), (2) reprint the work for distribution, (3) make the work available for purchase and distribution after the ASARS Symposium, and (4) grant requestors one-time rights to reprint the work. ASD agrees to provide me with appropriate authorship credit and acknowledgment each time it publishes or republishes the work, and to require sub-licensors to also provide appropriate authorship credit and acknowledgments. As an author, I warrant that all opinions contained in submitted works are solely my own, and do not reflect official positions of any government or institutional affiliation. ASD is hereby authorized to use my name, likeness, picture and biographical material during and after the ASARS Symposium to advertise and publicize any use of the work but not to endorse the Symposium or any other activity of ASD.

ASD understands and agrees that the above grant of rights does not constitute a transfer of copyright on individual submitted works and that the respective author(s) remain(s) free to present the materials or revised versions thereof elsewhere.

In granting this consent and release, I/we acknowledge and agree that ASD shall be under no obligation to pay any government agency or affiliated institution for delivery of any service I perform as a result of this agreement, or for the permission/license that I/we have granted to ASD to reproduce, publish and distribute the work as set forth above.

By clicking "Yes", I further represent and pledge that I and any co-authors are the sole authors and owners of the work and all rights in and to all portions of the aforementioned work; that the work is original; that it does not violate or infringe on any personal or property rights of others, whether common law or statutory; that it contains nothing libelous or otherwise contrary to law. I warrant that I am authorized and empowered to enter into this agreement on my own behalf, and on the behalf of any co-authors. I further represent and pledge that the work contains no material from other works protected by copyright that has been used without the written consent of the copyright owner, and that I have provided (or are simultaneously providing) ASD with copies of all such required written author consents. I understand that members of the media may be present at this event, and that the information I present is for the public record and may be used in articles that they write about the Symposium. I acknowledge that I have read this consent and release prior to signing it and that I understand its contents. I understand that ASD is relying on this agreement and release and that my release and consent are irrevocable.
